



FIRE SAFETY INFORMATION FOR EVENT VISITORS

Venue: Dynamic Earth, Edinburgh

Your safety is our priority. Please take a moment to read the following important information to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience during your visit.

EMERGENCY EXITS AND EVACUATION

Upon arrival, identify the nearest emergency exits. These are clearly marked with green signage throughout the venue. In the event of an evacuation, lifts must not be used under any circumstances. If the fire alarm sounds—a continuous ringing bell or siren—stop all activities immediately and follow the instructions of Dynamic Earth staff and event marshals. Do not assume the alarm is a drill unless explicitly confirmed.

EVACUATION PROCEDURE

Leave all personal belongings behind and proceed calmly to the designated assembly point outside the building. The main assembly point for Dynamic Earth is located in the **Car Park Area adjacent to Holyrood Road**. Remain at the assembly point until you are advised by staff or emergency services that it is safe to return.

GENERAL FIRE SAFETY RULES

Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the venue. Fire exits and escape routes must remain unobstructed at all times. If you notice any hazards, such as blocked exits or unusual smells, report them immediately to a member of staff.

ACCESSIBILITY AND ASSISTANCE

If you require assistance during an evacuation, please inform a member of staff upon arrival. Dedicated personnel are available to support visitors with mobility needs or other requirements.

IN CASE OF FIRE

If you discover a fire, activate the nearest fire call point and alert a member of staff. Do not attempt to extinguish the fire unless you are trained and it is safe to do so.
